Dear Laurence:

I had been after Metro for your \$7,000 for the past week, but owing to Rubin's absence from town, same was held up. I finally got check this morning, which I have already deposited in your Chemical National Bank account.

I also deposited in your account check for \$123.07, same being one-half of the music royalties on "Rainbow" received by me for the period ending March 31st, 1929, the other half having been deposited in Oscar's account.

As per your suggestion, I am enclosing check for \$2,000 drawn on your Chemical National account and for income tax purposes, I am also enclosing receipted bill showing payment to me of \$2,000 for professional services.

On March 6th, 1929, I sent you statement showing a balance due you from the "Rainbow" motion picture moneys of \$1820.52. Since that time, I have had the following disbursements against said balance:


