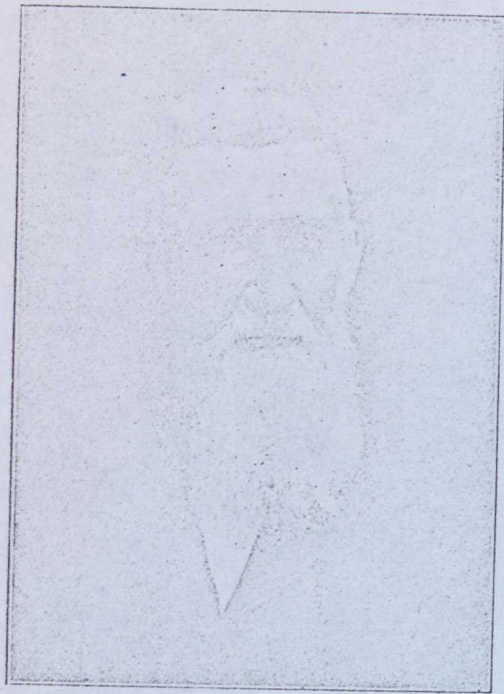

Brother Queen was born May 6, 1831, and spent a long life of usefulness in the Kingdom. He was converted early in life. He was married in 1855 to Miss Mary C. Carson who was a great help to him in his work for the Master. To this union six children were born. Rev. A. C. Queen is one of the surviving sons.

Brother Queen served as lieutenant of Co. I., 62nd N. C. Reg. in the Civil war and was ordained to the ministry by Johns Creek church. He was in the organization of most of the churches in Jackson county and served as pastor of many of the churches in this and surrounding counties.

He fell asleep January 6, 1908, and was followed by his wife February 8, 1908. They rest side by side in Sols Creek burying ground.
