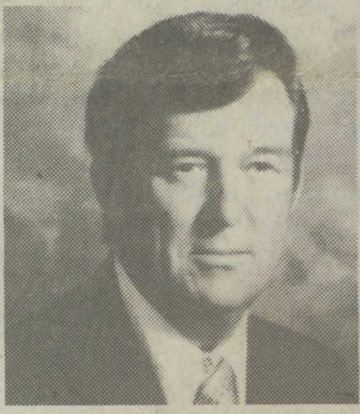

Former pastor to preach Selma Baptist revival



Dr. Frank Zedick, pastor Emeritus of Grace Baptist Church, Durham, and former pastor of Selma Baptist Church, will be the guest preacher for the local church's spring revival scheduled for April 14-19.

Using the theme "Witnessing-Giving: These Go Together," the revival will be held nightly at 7:30 except on Sunday when the time will be 7 o'clock.

A mini-concert will be held 15 minutes prior to each service. Music director is Edwin Jewell. Serving as organists will be Kris Walker and Melba Woodruff, and pianist, Elisabeth Jewell.

On Monday through Thursday the week of the revival, the church's deacons will lead cottage prayer meetings. Deacon families will also be recognized each night.

Dr. Zedick served as pastor of Selma Baptist Church from 1955 to 1959, at which time he accepted the pastorate of First Baptist Church in Dillon SC. He went from there to Grace Baptist in Durham in 1980. Prior to coming to Selma he was pastor in Middlesex, Bailey, Fountain Inn, SC, and associate minister in N. Charleston, SC.

He holds a BA degree from Furman University, Greenville, SC, a Bachelor of Divinity, Master of Theology and Doctor of Ministry from Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, Wake Forest, and was adjunct professor at McCormick Theological Seminary, Chicago, 1974-75.

While in Selma Dr. Zedick served a moderator of Johnston Baptist Association for two terms.

A native of Pennsylvania, he is married to the former Mary Pridgen, and the couple has four adult children.
