
The following telegram was sent to Ben Waple, Federal Communications Commission, Washington, D.C., July 4, 1967. I thought you might like a copy for your files:

Respectfully urge you re^scind FCC ruling that WFDD-FM reduce broadcasting power. WFU station dedicated to highest ideals of radio broadcasting. Only good music station in Piedmont section of North Carolina. Regrettable that commercial interests of WGHP-TV High Point favored over educational programming of WFDD-FM. Urge reconsideration of order.

As you can see, I "fudged" a little in saying WFDD was the only station broadcasting good music; WSJS-FM is doing so five days a week. We have often enjoyed Ken Johnson's work on the latter.

I feel, despite the "compromise" solution, that the community and especially the university community have been cheated by the decision. I was glad to see so many letters in the paper agreeing with this view in principle. Let me know if I can help.
