Black History Month Program Set At Church

L. M. Dunn will be the guest speaker for the Black History Month program at Aaron Creek Baptist Church at noon Sunday (Feb. 22).

Music for the program will be given by Mrs. Gaynell Royster, Mrs. Ollie Lindsey and the St. Matthew's gospel choir.

Dunn, assistant principal at J. F. Webb High School, is a graduate of DuBois High School (now Wake Forest-Rolesville Middle School) and is a native of Wake Forest. He received a bachelor of science degree in architectural engineering from North Carolina A & T State University in 1949 and a master of science degree in mathematics from the same institution in 1955.

He has taught mathematics, health and physical education at Toler School (1949-1967) and from 1967 to 1970 he was principal of Toler. He became an assistant principal at Webb in 1970.

His school service includes athletic director, basketball coach, Glee Club assistant advisor, fancy drill team advisor, Math Club advisor, and school treasurer. He has worked with school transportation for 37 years, this being one of his duties at Webb today.

He has been affiliated with 10 civic groups and five religious organizations.
