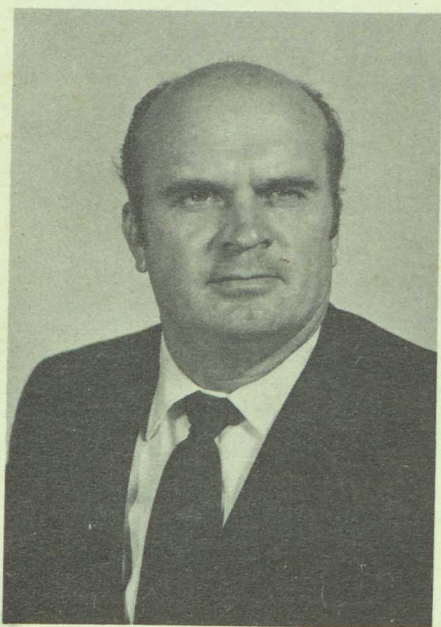

HAROLD McKINNISH was born near Hendersonville, N. C., Jan. 30, 1933. He was reared in the mountains of Western North Carolina and learned many of the ways of life at an early age. In 1944, at the age of 11, he was converted in the Moores Grove Methodist Church. Later that year he was baptized and became a member of the Ebenezer Baptist Church.

On the 12th day of April, 1949, at the age of sixteen, Harold McKinnish surrendered to preach the Gospel.

He graduated from High School in 1951, attended North Greenville Jr. College and then graduated from the Fruitland Baptist Bible Institute, in 1956.

His ministry for these 25 years has been that of a Pastor-Evangelist. The pastorates have been in North and South Carolina. He pastored 4 churches in the Carolina Association of Henderson County.

His revival work has carried him into 10 states from Florida to Ohio. Humbly and gratefully he acknowledges he has preached in 50 churches in his home county, held 8 different pastorates in two states and averaged 10 revivals per year since 1950.
