He was born June 3, 1918 in Union County, NC to Willie Broadway and Betty Austin Broadway. He was baptized at Old North Park Baptist Church in High Point, NC. He married Lucy Williard of Surry County on June 6, 1936. They had one child who died in infancy. He was ordained to preach on November 28, 1948 at High Rock Baptist Church, where he pastored a total of twelve years at two different times. He was licensed to preach on May 19, 1946 at Fairmont Baptist Church in High Point. During his years as a pastor he has pastored at approximately thirteen churches in the Liberty Association. He retired as pastor from Cedar Lodge Baptist Church in Thomasville in June 1985. He was called out of retirement to serve at Lick Creek Church and we have been blessed to have him.
