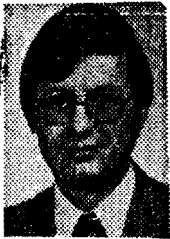


Mission Pastor

Pastorate Accepted

Rev. John Richard Booth has accepted a call to become pastor of the Oakdale Baptist Church and will assume this position on Oct. 1.

Oakdale Baptist Church was organized January, 1962, and Mr. Booth will be its fourth pastor. Rev. G. Carroll Jordan has been interim pastor.

Mr. Booth comes to Oakdale from Sperring Memorial Baptist Church, Fayetteville, where he has served as pastor for the past three years. He is a graduate of University of Florida and Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary at Wake Forest.

First Baptist Church, Hawthorne, Fla., and, prior to going to Sperring Memorial Baptist Church, he was pastor of the Rocky Cross Baptist Church at Middlesex. He has also served four years active duty with the U. S. Air Force.

While in Fayetteville, Mr. Booth was active in the work of the New South River Baptist Association as co-chairman of the emergency relief committee; member of CONTACT telephone ministry board of directors, association council and first vice president of Fayetteville Ministerial Association.

He has also been active in civic and community activities in Fayetteville.

He is a native of Jacksonville, Fla. He and his wife, Linda Mae Booth, have a son, Paul, nine years old, and daughter, Jennifer, 10 months old. They will move to Statesville as soon as they can locate a home.
