Rev. Warren accepts call at Burgaw

BURGAW — The Rev. E.P. Warren, pastor of Lee Park Baptist Church, Monroe, has accepted a call to be pastor of Forest Hills Baptist Church on Rt. 2, Burgaw, with his first sermon to be preached Sunday.

The Rev. Mr. Warren, his wife and 14-year-old son moved into the parsonage Thursday. Two other sons are students, one at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and the other at Union Theological Seminary, Richmond, Va.
