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Good News Baptist calls interim pastor

The membership of Good News Baptist Church on N.C. 125 south of Roanoke Rapids has called Rev. Lawrence D. Evans to serve as interim pastor during the period that the Pastor Search Committee works to seek a full-time minister.

Rev. Evans, a resident of Rocky Mount, retired in October of 1986 after serving 20 years as pastor of Southside Baptist Church there. In March, the Southside congregation bestowed the title of pastor emeritus upon him for his years of dedicated service.

In addition to the pastorate at Southside, Rev. Evans has ministered in Johnston County and in Alabama. Most recently he served as interim pastor of Englewood Baptist Church in Rocky Mount.

A native of Virginia, Rev. Evans is a graduate of Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary in Wake Forest. He is also a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II. He and his wife, the former Joyce M. Fisher of Huntsville, Ala., have two daughters, a son, and four grandchildren.
