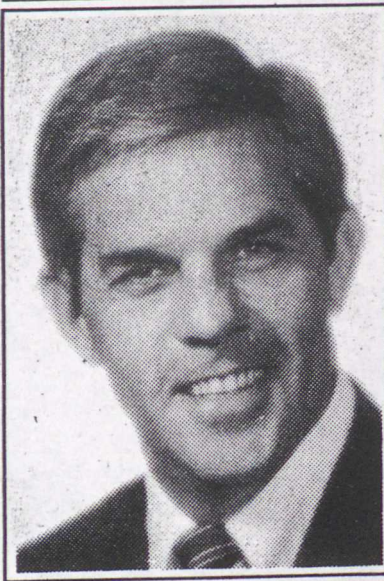
Mr. Rummage graduated from Pfeiffer College in 1984 with a
