The late Rev. L. C. Roberts

Born in 1866, the Rev. L. C. Roberts had passed well beyond the three score and ten limit of life's span. A man of mature years when he was ordained to the work of the ministry, he served well as pastor of several churches and as moderator of the French Broad Association. Three children blessed the home, two of whom—Theoria and May Thelma—passed on before him, Mrs. Luther Howell, alone, surviving. He died on September 15, 1940, being the oldest minister in years and in point of service in our Association, and these Minutes are dedicated to this faithful servant of our Lord. He was ordained July 10, 1898 at the Laurel Branch church.

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
