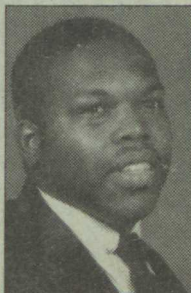

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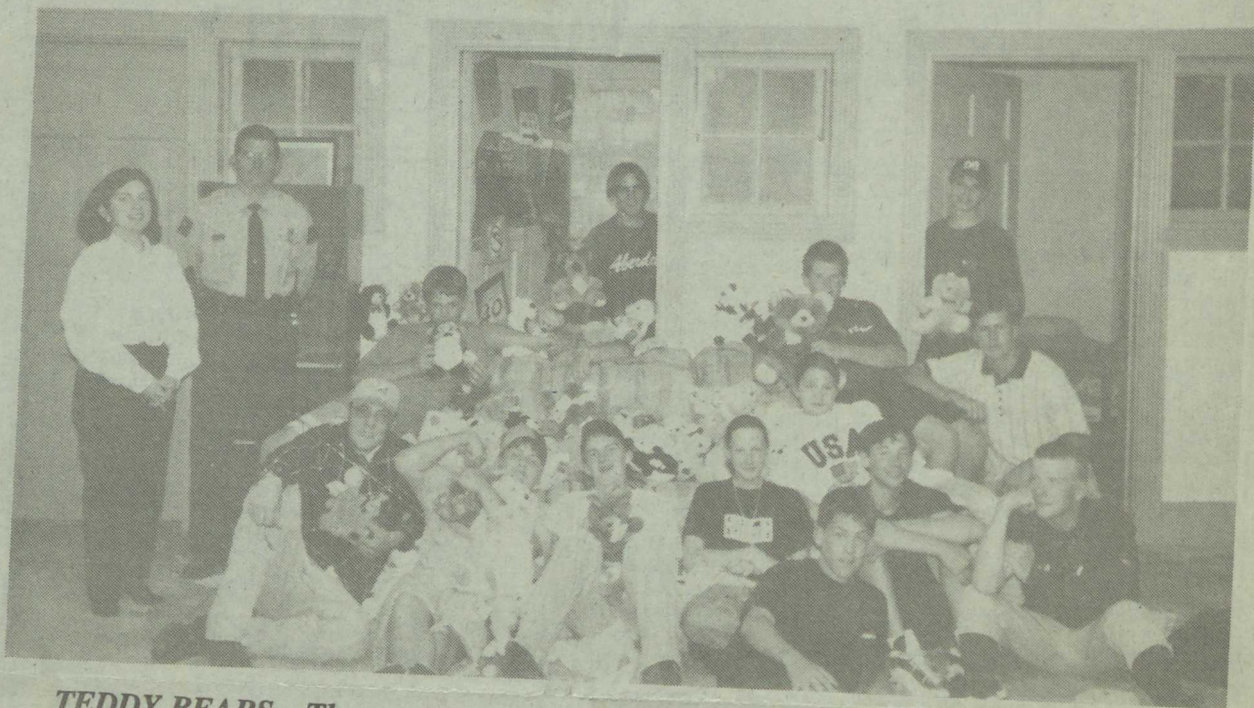

Aberdeen First Baptist... That Sentinel On A Hill

Aberdeen First Baptist Church was organized in 1894, about a century after the Scotch-Presbyterians arrived via the Cape Fear River to form Bethesda and five years before the circuit-riding Methodists became a congregation in 1899. Sixty-two years later, the Baptists moved from a white clapboard church on Main Street to a three-story, four-columned, red-brick building overlooking US 1.

A sentinel on a hill, framed by two huge oak trees, today the First Baptist Church of Aberdeen (the name changed in 1948) and a tall, silver water tower across the highway compete for dominance as they welcome travelers going north and south.

My nine-year-old soul was saved in the frame church. I "took the walk" down the carpeted aisle toward our pastor and gave my life, to Christ as the choir sang "Just as I Am." One week later, on a hot summer Sunday night, I was baptized. Grabbing me by the back of the neck with his left hand, smothering my nose and mouth with his right, the Rev. Eugene Dees plunged me into the cold water-filled baptism and declared that I was saved in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost. Struggling up from suffocation, I found my footing, wiped my eyes and nose, and gasped for breath.

My spiritual journey continued in the brick edifice with GA's, choir, Sunday School, worship ser-

Bible verses, mostly about fear and guilt (which I thought was just a "Baptist thing," but many of my Catholic friends had the same experience).

"Sentence prayers" (which I interpreted as "sent us prayers" until I was five years old) were said each morning after a short devotion. One by one, with heads bowed, we all prayed the same "sentence," quickly and in an embarrassed monotone:

*Thankyouformy blessingsandbless
themicmissionariesinforeignfieldsandh
elpmetobegoodamen.*

As we grew older, we were more specific with the blessing of the missionaries. Lottie Moon should be a saint for all the prayers offered up for her; and the Zeb Moss family (always in a "foreign field" somewhere on the other side of the world) was very real to us, their annual Christmas letter and picture being prominently displayed on the bulletin board near our minister's office.

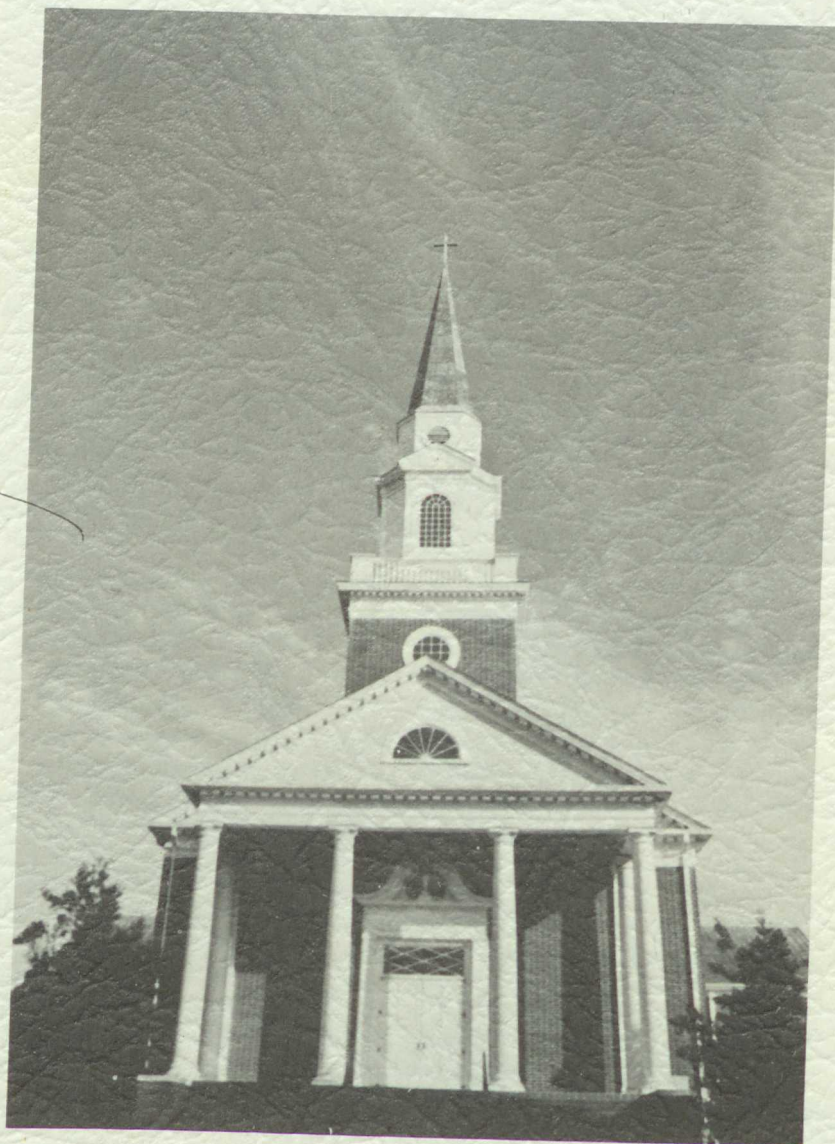
Refreshments were a very important part of the Bible school program (and any Baptist gathering) and provided a much needed break for teachers and an unnecessary/necessary source of glucose for already overactive children. We were served watered-down Kool-Aid (TM) (cherry being the favorite as well as the most difficult stain to remove when spilled down the front of one's shirt) and homemade chocolate chip or oatmeal cookies provided by the members of the Women's Missionary society. Lemonade and A&P (TM)

stir a breeze from the crowded pews in which they sat. Mosquitoes and night bugs, drawn toward the suspended lights, ventured through the opened windows; Aqua-Net (TM) sprayed bouffants attracted an occasional yellowjacket which circled above an unsuspecting female head, attempting to land.

Except for a few, we were a happy, angelic group. There were always several who sang too loud and/or off key, and a lone, uninterested male who looked at the floor refusing to participate and fearful of arriving home too late to watch "Bonanza." Shy little girls who would grow up to be beauties stood next to nose pickers and wiggle-worms. Too-tall-for-their-age "tomboys," uncomfortable in dresses (I was one), hid on the back row next to the "mischievous" boys who should have been on Ritalin (TM) had it been available.

After the traditional tour of classrooms, students, parents, and guests were invited to the recreation hall for the adult version of Baptist refreshments: fruit punch (ginger ale and pineapple juice mixed in equal parts) served from a cut-glass punchbowl with matching cups. A white-sheet-covered, collapsible metal table, decorated with fresh summer flowers from some generous, green-thumbed circle member's garden held sterling silver trays and bowls, containing cake squares, mixed nuts, and mints. While parents visited, boys escaped outside into the cool night air, shedding coats and ties as they raced up the steps. Girls stood in little groups, carefully balancing

HISTORICAL NOTES

On the fourth Sunday in May (27th) in the year of our Lord 1894, a meeting was held at Aberdeen for the specific purpose of organizing a Baptist church in this small Moore County town. Present for that meeting were the following: J.L. Holland, W.R. Hunter, M.H. Holland, A.F. Yates, T.S. Carrol, H.H. Powell, C.A. Adams, E.W. Yates, J.W. Fagan, P.V. Holland, Ina V. Holland, Florence Yates, Louisa Randal, N.J. Fagan, Maggie Sharp, Olivia Drake, Ann Roberts, Dora Knight, P.A. Yates, Susan Gunter, Flora Hunter, and M.M. McLeod. The organizational meeting was held in an old building known as "The School-Town Hall Building" located on the site of the old Aberdeen High School building that burned many years ago. The name "Aberdeen Baptist Church" was adopted as the official name.

On the fourth Sunday in July, 1894, the committee on church building reported progress and a collection was taken for the church building fund, which amounted to \$6.35. Also, at this meeting the Articles of Faith and Covenant were adopted. There is no record of the date the first building was completed.

On August 8th, 1948, in a regular business meeting the church voted to change the name of the church to "The First Baptist Church of Aberdeen". On November 27, 1945 in a regular meeting of the Deacons, the Deacons voted to appoint a study committee for the purpose of expanding the church program with special emphasis to be given the construction of a new building. O. Leon Seymour, Dr. E.M. Medlin, Curtis Lawhon, J.M. Taylor, and W.W. Norris were appointed to this committee. Rev. Zeb Caudle was pastor at this time. On May 1, 1954, plans were set in motion to actually begin construction. Dr. E.M. Medlin served as Chairman of the Building Committee and J.M. Taylor served as Chairman of the Finance Committee. The new building was completed and the first service was held in the church on September 30, 1956.

First Baptist Church has a grand heritage and a promising future. We earnestly seek the prayers of all Christians as we endeavor to carry the torch that has been handed to us from our glorious forebearers.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

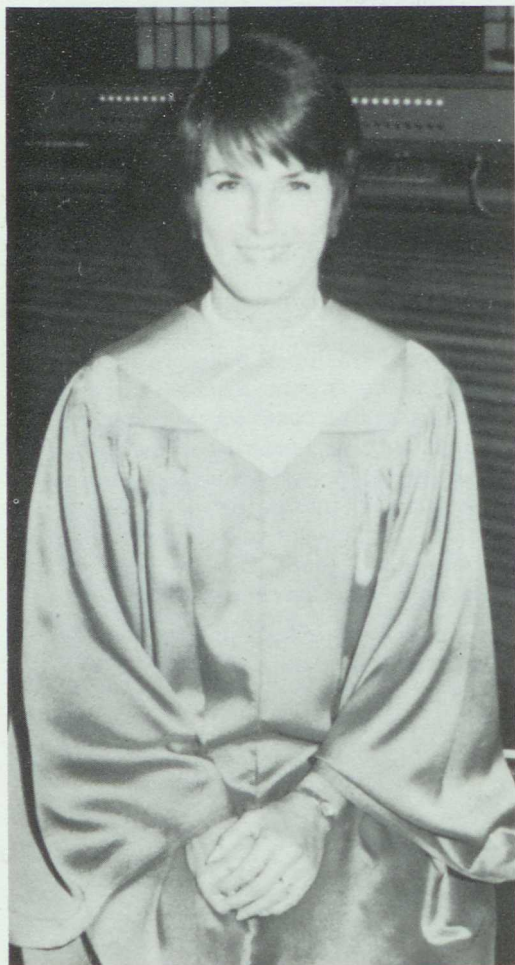

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Aberdeen First Baptist Kicks Off Weekly Programs

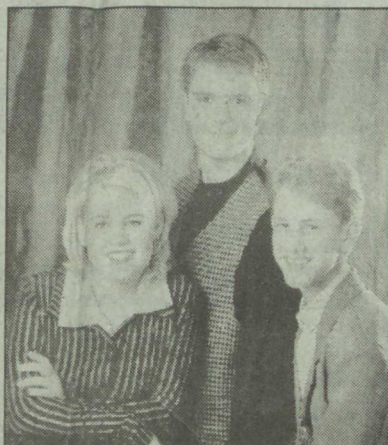
