WINDSOR, Aug. 6—Funeral services for the Rev. J. E. Copeland, 81, retired Baptist minister who died Saturday morning at 9 o'clock at the home of his daughter, Mrs. J. L. White, will be conducted Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Askewville Baptist Church by the Rev. Robert A. Gardner, assisted by the Rev. J. B. Hewitt.

A native of Perquimans County, he was the son of David L. and Kizah Chappell Copeland and husband of the late Artimacia Winslow Copeland.

He was active in the West Chowan Ministerial Association. His first pastorate was served in 1901.

Survivors, in addition to Mrs. White, include four sons, Carle-

ton N. Copeland of Murray Hill, Livingston C. Copeland of Colerain, Roger C. Copeland of Windsor and Edward L. Copeland of Norfolk; three daughters, Mrs. E. B. Hollowell of Winfall, Mrs. Earl Jernigan of Colerain and Mrs. W. W. Campbell of Rocky Mount; 27 grandchildren and six great grandchildren.

Burial will follow in Edgewood Cemetery here.
