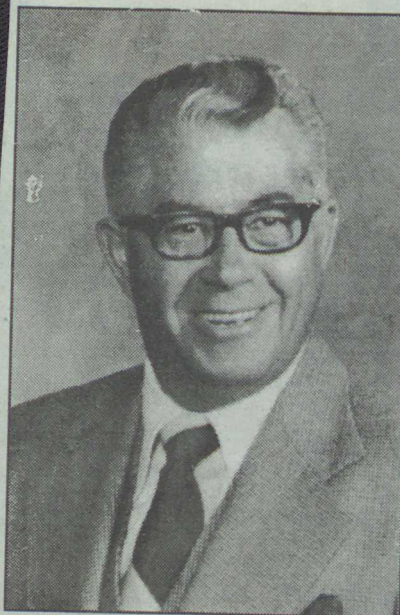

## New Pastor At Calvary

The Rev. Don Wilson of Greenville became the pastor of Calvary Baptist Church, Landrum, on March 12.

A native of Pennsylvania and raised in New York, the Rev. Mr. Wilson was an entertainer and ban vocalist in the 1940's and 1950's. He was a U.S. Marine Corps veteran of World War II and the Korean War and later served as a chaplain in the U.S. Air Force attaining the rank of Lt. Colonel.

The Rev. Mr. Wilson is a graduate of Bob Jones University where he received his B.A. and B.D. degrees and has served on the Board of Trustees for 36 years. He has been a full-time evangelist for many years and has recorded for Mark Fine Records and is a published author.

## New Pastor At Calvary Baptist

Don Wilson of Greenville, S.C. has become the pastor of Calvary Baptist Church, Church St., Landrum as of Sunday, March 12.

Born in Pennsylvania and brought up in New York, Wilson was an entertainer and band vocalist in the 40s and early 50s. He was converted to Christ in 1951 while serving with the Marines at Camp Lejeune, N.C. and is a veteran of W.W. II and the Korean Campaign. He subsequently served as a Chaplain, Lt.Col., CAD/USAF.

Wilson received a B.A. and B.D. from Bob Jones University and has served on the Board of Trustees for the college for 36 years.

Wilson had for many years communicated the Scriptures to the public as a newspaper columnist, radio broadcaster and television programmer, in addition to a regular preaching itinerary in hundreds of independent Baptist churches throughout America as a full-time evangelist. His ministry included work as a recording artist for Mark Fine Records and as a published author both in national periodicals and books.

Wilson and his wife, Nancy, have no children.
