Funeral for Dr. Joseph C. Deaton Jr., 53, of 522 Eight Street, New Cumberland, Pa., who died June 8, 1993, will be at 2 p.m. Saturday at Florida Street Baptist Church.



Burial will be in **Deaton** Guilford Memorial Park.

A native of Greensboro, he was a graduate of Wake Forest, Southwestern Theological Seminary, and Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary at Wake Forest. He was director of Missions for Keystone Baptist Association with the Southern Baptist Convention and formerly for Macomb Baptist Association, Warren, Mich. He was former pastor of Oneida Baptist Church, Oneida, Ky., Fellowship Baptist Church, Bucyrus, Ohio, and Wilsons Mills Baptist Church, Wilsons Mills. He was a member of Red Land Baptist Church, New Cumberland, Pa.

Surviving are wife, Patricia A. Deaton; daughters, Loanna Deaton Bradley of Austin, Texas, Andrea L. Deaton of New Cumberland, Pa.; father, Joseph C. Deaton Sr. of Lenior; brother, David Deaton of Davenport, Fla.; sisters, Kay Layton of Summerfield, Patricia D. Nelson of Mount Holly.

Pastor Joe Deaton To Serve Abroad

The Rev. Joe Deaton, pastor of Wilson's Mills Baptist Church, left by plane Thursday for the mission fields of Central and South America where he will spend a short tour of service.

Mr. Deaton was accompanied by the Rev. Baxter Walker of Fayetteville, founder and leader of International Schools of Prayer and Evangelism, who will travel to San Andres Island, Colombia, South America to conduct the School for the First Baptist Church.

A mission group spokesman comments: "Mr. Deaton is a part of an ever-increasing number of ministers and laymen who are taking an active interest in mission work beyond their churches and immediate communities. They are going to the international fields that are serviced by their congregations and are doing what they can to strengthen the missionaries' work. Mr. Deaton will return with first-hand information and pictures of the church's outreach ministry."

While abroad, the mission group will visit the Southern Baptist Language School for newly appointed missionaries in

Wilson's Mills Pastor Resigns

The Rev. Joe C. Deaton, pastor of Wilson's Mills Baptist Church for the past three years, has resigned to accept the position of area director of missions for the Macomb Association in Michigan. His resignation will be effective October 1.

Mr. Deaton is a native of Greensboro and came to the Wilson's Mills pastorate from Ohio, where he pastored the Fellowship Baptist Church, Bucyrus.

He has recently completed class requirements for the doctor of ministry degree at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, Wake Forest. He has served as a volunteer chaplain at Johnston Memorial Hospital. In the Johnston Baptist Association, he was elected Vacation Bible School director and a member of the evangelism committee. Last February he was the teacher for the Association's Lay Evangelism School.

Mr. Deaton said that he is going into a new area of ministry under the sponsorship of the Southern Baptist Convention's Home Mission Board in co-operation with the Baptist State Convention of Michigan. Yet it

is similar to his experience in Ohio, he added.

He will have a four-county area beginning in the suburbs of Detroit and continuing northward along the eastern coastline. Seven of the present 15 churches are without pastors. One of his first responsibilities will be to help these churches get pastors. Many of the churches are weak and struggling, Mr. Deaton pointed out.

The Deatons, including wife, Pat, and daughters, Joanna and Andrea, expect to reside in Roseville near Detroit.
