PARKTON—The Rev. Ira O. Cartee of Siler City, Rt. 3, has accepted a call to become pastor of Parkton Baptist Church and moved to Parkton Monday.

He comes to Parkton from the Rives Chapel Baptist Church near Siler City after serving that church since March of 1963.

He began preaching at the age of fifteen and was ordained January 26, 1956 by the Curtis Baptist Church, Augusta, Georgia. During the past fifteen years he has preached in over one hundred churches in Florida, Georgia, South Carolina and North Carolina.

The new pastor, a native of Florida, is 30 years old. He is a graduate of Richmond Academy in Augusta, Ga.; Junior College, Augusta, Ga.; Furman University, Greenville, South Carolina; and South-Seminary at Wake Forest.

He is married to the former Miss Maxine Jackson and they have three children.
