

Baptist Minister Resigns Pastorate

The Rev. Marvin B. Aycock Jr., who has served as pastor of Fellowship Baptist Church at 1075 Teague Road for six years, has resigned effective July 31.

While at Fellowship, Aycock has been active in the Pilot Mountain Baptist Association. He is a member of its executive committee, chairman of the Christian life and Christian action committee and a member of the resolutions committee. He also has served the missions committee and was superintendent of teacher training in the Sunday school division.

In recent years, he said, he has become interested in the church reaching into the community, a work he would like to see the Christian church do more of.

Aycock said he will announce his plans within a few weeks. He hopes to remain in the area.

Aycock, 37, came to Fellowship as its second full-time pastor and began serving the congregation on the first day in its new building. He came here from Elizabeth City where he was pastor of Riverside Baptist Church for three years.

He is a graduate of Furman University and Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary at Wake Forest. He also attended the School of Pastoral Care at Baptist Hospital.

He is married to the former Sally Thompson of Easley, S. C.

As coordinator of the alcoholism program, Aycock will be able to develop and coordinate the alcoholic services in Stanly County.

As funds are appropriated, he will expand the work into Anson County and this will mean he will be supervising counselors in both counties.

Aycock, 37, came here from Elizabeth City, where he was pastor for three years. He is a graduate of Furman University and Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary at Wake Forest. He also attended the School of Pastoral Care at Baptist Hospital.
