nerstone Missionary Baptist Church in Greenville.

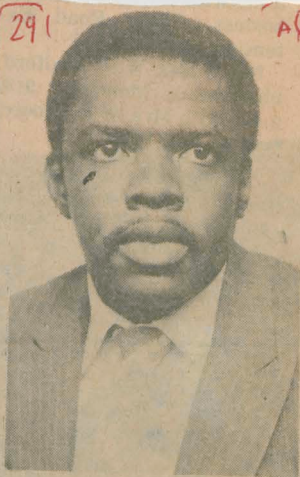
Moore is married to the former Pauline Mills of Winterville and they have two children.

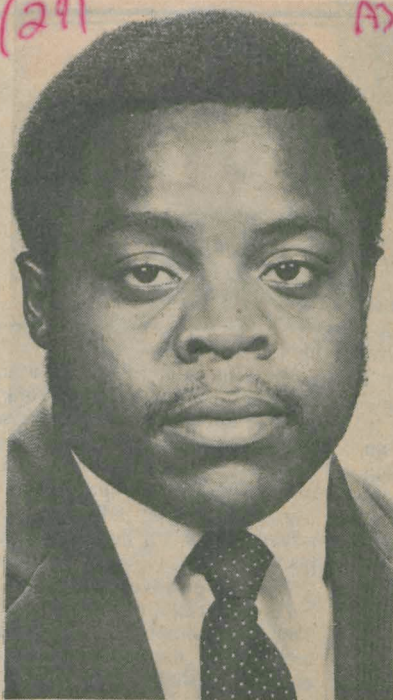

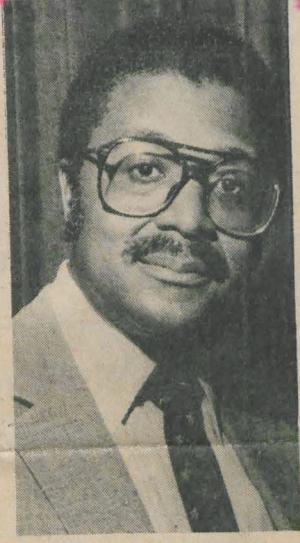

He then pursued graduate education at North Carolina Central University, Durham, with consecration in administration and supervision and a minor in sociology. A part of his theological training was done at Shaw Divinity School, Raleigh. Upon moving to Philadelphia, he entered in the urban Theological Institute of the Lutheran Seminary where he is a candidate for the Master of Divinity Degree.

He has served as a teacher at Washington Elementary School, assistant principal of the South Ayden High School, and principal of the Falkland Elementary School.

Moore has served as vice moderator of the Old Eastern Association and presently serves as vice moderator of the Pennsylvania Baptist Association, director of Christian Education Department for the Pennsylvania Baptist State Convention, assistant treasurer for Big Sisters of America, vice chairman of Philadelphia PUSH, board of directors and on the executive committee for the Philadelphia Baptist Association.
