Mrs. Gibson is the former Miss Vivian Humble of Kannapolis and the family includes three children and three grandchildren.

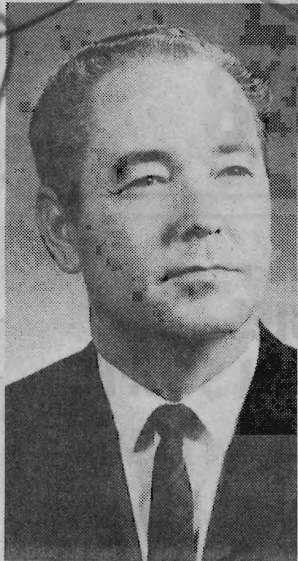
An employe of Cannon Mills Co. for 28 years, Gibson received his education at Concord schools, Burton Institute in Charlotte, Evans

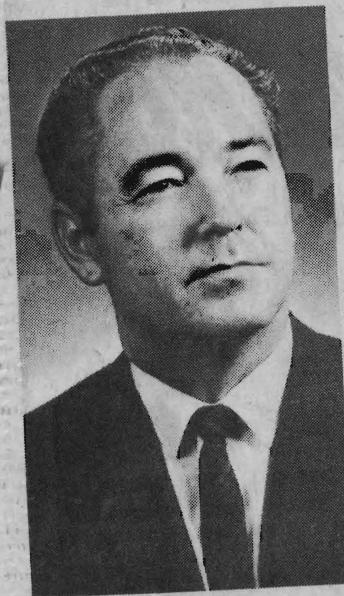
