



Alfred Nehemiah Huneycutt

(July 26, 1912-May 31, 1993)

Rev. Alfred N. Huneycutt was born in Stanly County on July 26, 1912 to Adam Luther and Seneca Burris Huneycutt. A graduate of Oakboro High School and Fruitland Baptist Bible Institute, he was ordained into the ministry on September 4, 1949.

Alfred has served several churches: Capelsie in Montgomery County; Barbee's Grove and Union Grove in Stanly County; Riverside, Beard's Chapel, and White Lake in Bladen County; Ivanhoe in Sampson County, and Pleasant Hill in Union County.

He returned to Riverside in Bladen County in 1971 for his second tenure, and stayed until he retired in 1986. Upon his retirement he returned to the Big Lick community in Stanly County.

Alfred was preceded in death by his first wife, Autie Mae Huneycutt. This couple had one child, Janette. He married R. Ann Huneycutt in 1941 and three children were born to this union: Julia, Maurice, and Susan. There are 8 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren.

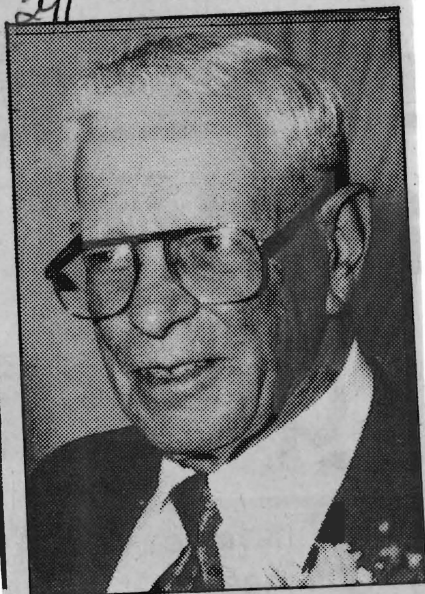
