Wales, abt-1645 = Emory, before 1686; m. 2^d
1703; d. 1721. 2^d wife Mary Holloway, dau.
of Adam + Hannah (Hayward). 8 ch.

II. Capt. Jonathan, Ellersbegan, mason +
Carpenter; b. Marlboro 1717; lived in Ellersbegan
Mass. from 1749. Served in the Quebec exped.
of 1659, & is said to have made the coffin for
the fallen general Wolfe. To m. 1772; d.
1784. He was an active + prosperous man,
blind in his last years, & had several chil-
dren whom he never saw. He had 5 wives
& 16 children who lived to grow up. 2^d wife
(mother of Lydia) Mary — 4 ch.
[Capt. Jon. was the 1st to write his name "Oak"
after he went to m. Doubtless Lydia was
bapt. "Oak". & descend from John² a
brother of Jonathan H. & Co.]
