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Minister Dies In Traffic Accident

A Lenoir minister and businessman was killed Sunday in a head-on collision on N.C. 18 near the Cedar Rock community.

Another man was seriously injured.

The Rev. Ed Price, 78, pastor of Grandin Baptist Church, was killed when the 1996 Lincoln he was driving reportedly crossed the center line and collided with a 1987 Chevrolet pickup truck driven by Gary Icenhour, 44, of Lenoir.

Icenhour was transferred to N.C. Baptist Hospital suffering from facial fractures, a fractured leg and a fractured foot.

Price died of multiple injuries.

The accident occurred at 12:35 p.m. between the two entrances to Cedar Rock Country Club.

Price owned and operated City Auto Parts from 1948 until he sold the business to Flowers

Auto Parts in 1987. He also owned Ed Price Realty in Lenoir.

He had pastored, or been interim pastor of, more than 10 area Baptist churches, and had been the pastor of Grandin Baptist Church on Grandin Road for nine years.

He had preached at Grandin's Sunday morning service and was on his way home at the time of the accident.
