

PARDUE

Rev. A. T. Pardue was born near Roaring River, September 14, 1857, and died in the same vicinity July 12, 1936. In early life he accepted Christ as his Saviour and was active in His service throughout his long life. At the age of 24 he was set apart for the active ministry and for 55 years devoted himself almost solely to that work. During that period he baptized more than 3,000 persons. He often preached to crowds in public places--on the street corners, and elsewhere. He was associational missionary in both the Brushy Mountain and the Brier Creek Associations. Surely few men have followed more closely the guidance of the Holy Spirit.
