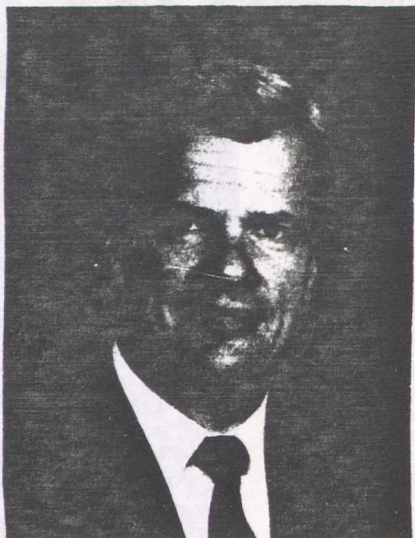

Mr. Marvin Yarborough has accepted the position of minister of youth with Hope Valley Baptist Church.

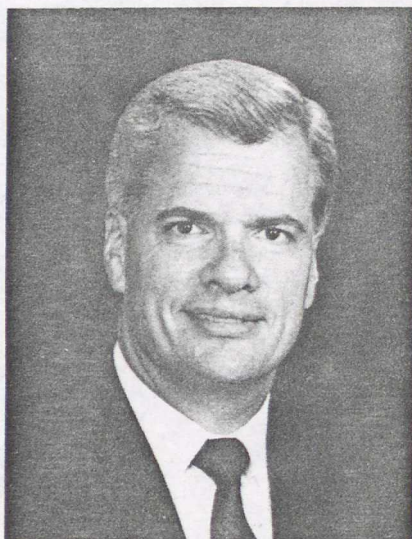
Rev. Ernest Holt has accepted the position of interim pastor of Faith Baptist Church.
